### **AN64 - Helicopter to Montserrat Volcano**

Fly above the active Soufrière Hills Volcano on this incredible journey over evacuated villages and natural wonders. Embark on a 30-mile flight over the crystal-clear Caribbean Sea to the neighboring island of Montserrat. The Soufrière Hills Volcano rises an impressive 3,000 feet, dominating the island's volatile landscape, and towering above the Tar River Gorge. The volcano remains active to this day, spewing ash, smoke, and steam. In 1997, when the volcano erupted, two-thirds of the island became uninhabitable. Soar over the "exclusion zone," restricted to ground transportation and habitation. See evacuated villages, the destroyed airport, and marvel at the former capital of Plymouth, buried under 40 feet of ash in places. Learn about how volcanic ash and pyroclastic flows have reshaped the landscape. Marvel at an active volcano that can only be viewed by helicopter. Then, enjoy incredible views of Antigua's spectacular coastline on your flight back to the island.

- Marvel at the ruins of a modern day Pompeii as you soar over the off-limits "exclusion zone."
- Experience an incredible bird's eye view of the volatile and active Soufrière Hills Volcano.
- Soar over evacuated villages and the charred remains of the former capital, buried under 40 feet of ash in places.
- Take in breathtaking views of the turquoise Caribbean Sea and lovely coastline.

The island is just 20 miles long, so its amazing natural splendors and outdoor adventures are all within easy reach of port. Sun seekers can choose the beach that best suits their style, from the activity-filled De Palm Island to dazzling Palm Beach, one of Aruba's most glorious stretches of sand.

Your rugged ride will eventually take you to Arashi Beach, a favorite among locals for its aquamarine waters and soft sands. Cool off with a brisk swim and take a moment to unwind after your rough and tumble exploration of Aruba.

Grazing fish keep algae in check, while sponges filter waste. Peer out of the submarine's large portholes and look for sharks and other top predators. Reefs protect the coasts from high surf and also provide food and jobs to the people who reside around them. Marvel at coral, sunken ships, and sea life while enjoying an unforgettable tour approved by Dr. Ellen Prager whose commitment to the sea and to bringing ocean awareness to all people is evident through her engaging programs.

We make one final stop at the seaside UNESCO World Heritage Site - Historic Charles Fort before returning to the pier.

- St. John's Parish Church: See the beautiful interior, tombs of prominent islanders and spectacular Atlantic views at this colonial-era site.

After 20 years, this private collection of flowers and botanicals has finally been opened to the public. Marvel at the picturesque views and diverse specimens, including 300 different types of palm trees. After a stroll through the unique botanical landscape, you'll head over to Habitation Clément for a guided tour of the old distillery and historic buildings. View a wonderfully-preserved 18th century creole home, visit the old distillery—the site of the meeting between George Bush, Sr. and President François Mitterrand on the eve of the Gulf War. After your tour, visit Maison de Maître (the masters house), and Case-à-Lucie, where you can sample diverse local rums.

- Visit Balata Church—a smaller replica of the Sacré-Coeur church in Paris.

#### **KT15 - Caribbean Scenic Railway Tour**

Take a ride aboard the St. Kitts Scenic Railway, built nearly a century ago to transport sugar cane from the fields to the sugar mill in Basseterre. These days, with air-conditioned cars, the railway provides the most panoramic journey on St. Kitts – one that circles the entire island. Sip a tropical rum punch (or virgin fruit punch) and marvel at views of forested volcanic peaks rising 4,000 feet above sea level. Rumble through rustic villages and island farms on a ride that takes you across deep “ghuts” (canyons) by way of steel bridges. Along the way, your local guide will point out landmarks, including long-abandoned sugar cane plantations where nature has taken over, climbing the old chimneys and windmills. After the train ride, relax on a sightseeing drive along the southwest coast that provides views of Brimstone Hill Fortress and neighboring Nevis, birthplace of American statesman, Alexander Hamilton.

### **Highlights:**

- Listen to the rhythmic sounds of island music sung by the Scenic Railway Choir on your train ride.
- Discover the island's lush landscapes, notable landmarks, and historic sugar cane estates from the train's open-air observation deck.
- Take a scenic drive through the villages to the capital city of Basseterre onboard a sightseeing bus after your railway adventure.

### **KT93 - A Day Trip to Nevis with Lunch**
