## US DIRECT

### IMPROVE YOUR GUESTS BOARDING EXPERIENCE IN VANCOUVER

The US DIRECT program will provide participating guests express immigration and customs processing with the US and Canadian regulatory agencies at the Vancouver Airport and Pier. This program is available for sailings originating in Vancouver. Participating guests will be treated as “in transit” through Canada. By participating in the program we anticipate guests will save approximately two hours off the time they would normally spend in customs and immigration lines at the airport and piers.

The following Royal Caribbean International ships will be embarking in Vancouver, and participating in the US Direct program this season. Start dates are from May 25 through September 25, 2005:

**Vision of the Seas® , Serenade of the Seas® and Radiance of the Seas®**

#### Eligibility Requirements for US Direct

In order to be eligible for this program, the following conditions must be met:

- ◆ Participants must arrive into Vancouver International Airport on a flight arriving directly from the United States on the Day of Sailing.
- ◆ Participants must be US Citizens or Legal US residents.
- ◆ Participants are required to have Airport to Pier transfer, as a part of their flight package, OR purchase our cruise only transfers.
- ◆ Participants MUST ensure they have affixed their ship baggage tags before they leave home. Please note, guests will not need to claim their checked luggage having followed these procedures as their luggage will go directly to the ship upon arrival at Vancouver.

#### Purchasing a Cruise Only Transfer

In order for a cruise only guest to participate in the US Direct Program, it is strongly encouraged to pre-purchase a transfer in advance. For Airport to Pier purchase transfer options, please call a Royal Caribbean representative at (800) 327-6700.

Eligible guests will be able to purchase transfers from the airport to the pier upon arrival at Vancouver International Airport on a limited basis.

#### Arrival at Vancouver International Airport

Flights must arrive into Vancouver International Airport (YVR) between 9:30 AM & 2:00 PM on the day of sailing. All participating guests will be met at Vancouver International Airport prior to Canadian immigration. Please look for US Direct signs, and have proof of citizenship and bus transfer in hand.

#### Boarding of Ship

Once guests have boarded the ship, it is strongly recommended that they remain onboard in Vancouver. If they choose to depart the ship in Vancouver for any reason, they will be subject to all regulatory agencies processing by both Canadian and US officials.
