Guests will have to provide their own laundry detergent. Select laundry detergent will be available for purchase in our onboard shops.

Medical Services

We're excited to have you onboard, and our medical team will be there to assist you every step of the way!

Medical staff

In addition to our standard medical team of doctors, nurses, and medical secretary, we'll have additional medical support onboard Serenade of the Seas during our Ultimate World Cruise. And for the first time ever, we'll have a Dentist and Dental Assistant!

Also, depending on where we are travelling in the world and our access to satellite connection, tele-medicine services will be available.

Dentist

Although our Dentist will cover any dental emergency, please keep in mind that we won't have the same capabilities as a land-based facility. Regardless, our Dentist will provide services for a fee such as cleanings, fillings, dental fractures, repairs, extractions, crown restoration and root canals.

Special Needs

We encourage any guest with requests/questions regarding medical or special needs such as medical equipment, supplies like, CPAP machines, distilled water, diet offerings, medications, vaccines, and different medical concerns, to please complete the online medical form <u>here</u> by August 1st, 2023.

Our team will assess your request and contact you by the end of September 2023 with additional details.

Refills

We strongly recommend you bring a 9-month supply of the medications you regularly take. And at least a minimum of a 3-month supply is required.

Should you require a refill Rx onboard, we'll need to see a copy of your prescription. Please consult with your doctor to provide one to you prior to sailing. Digital prescriptions will also be accepted.

Vaccines/Testing

All guests **12** and older are <u>required</u> to be vaccinated against COVID-19, and boosters are recommended. The Yellow Fever vaccine is also strongly recommended, although it is not required.

While COVID-19 testing is not required to board the ship, if any port of call requires testing, complimentary testing will be available to you onboard.

Alcohol Policy for the Ultimate World Cruise

We know many of you plan to visit vineyards along our travels and we want to make sure you get to enjoy their wines!

Therefore, we've removed the onboard restrictions around wine and champagne only for our Ultimate World Cruise guests sailing on the full itinerary. World Cruisers sailing for the 274-nights may bring their wine & champagne onboard throughout the journey, which must be stored in guests' stateroom.

Unfortunately, we cannot store any for you as storage is limited onboard. The same exception will be applied to nonalcoholic beverages.

Spirits and other alcoholic beverages remain restricted from being brought onboard such as our standard policy.

Additionally, we'll be waiving our corkage fee in our bars and restaurants onboard.

Prohibited Items Policy

In addition, mattresses, coffee machines, microwave ovens, any large appliance, may not be brought onboard.
